Written work can be present by hand or published on the computer.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Create a fact file about Christine Darden (the final mathematician for NASA in Hidden Figures) (English) - Create a cartoon strip about an alien landing on Earth (English and Art) - Collect data about the amount of money spent on Space travel by different countries. Present this data in a chart of your choice e.g. bar graph/pie chart (Maths and Computing) - Bake your own space-themed cookies, cakes or biscuits, measuring all the ingredients yourself. They could be star, planet or rocket-shaped. Or something else! (DT and Maths) - Create your own solar system with the planets to scale. Get creative, you could even make it an edible solar system! (Maths and Science) - Create top trumps for the planets in the solar system (Art and Science). - Make an acrostic poem for one of the planets (English) - Design your own planet and describe it (Art and English) - Create a timeline to show the history of Space travel (History)

Spelling lists will be released if you would like to help your child at home with some extra practice.</p>
