Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to let you know that your child(ren) will be bringing home their End of Year Report today.

For children in all year groups, these reports will contain teacher judgements. This means that teachers have used their professional knowledge, using a range of evidence, to make a final judgement on your children's current attainment levels. Please see below for information about what these teacher judgements mean.

### **Reception (EYFS)**

Emerging – They have not yet met the objectives for that learning goal.

Developing - They are not yet secure but are beginning to meet the objectives for that learning goal.

Expected – They have met the objectives for that learning goal.

Reception reports will also contain children's Early Years Foundation Stage Profile.

### **Year 1 – Year 5**

E: Emerging within the stated year group's curriculum

D: Developing within the stated year group's curriculum

S: Secure within the stated year group's curriculum

GD: Working at greater depth within the stated year group's curriculum

The number beside the code indicates the year group your child is working within. This may not correspond with your child's current year group.

Year 1 reports will also contain their Phonics Screening Check (PSC) results on a separate report. Those children in Year 2 who retook the PSC this year, will receive their results along with the end of year report. This check had a pass mark of 32+ out of 40.

Year 4 report will also contain their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) results. This check had a pass mark of 25 out of 25.

### **Year 6**

PKS: Working below the expected standard for Key Stage 2

WTS: Working towards age-related expectations for Year 6

EXS: Working at age-related expectations for Year 6

GD: Working at greater depth within age-related expectations for Year 6

Results from the Year 6 Standardised Assessment Tests (SATs) will be included with Year 6 reports. These are separate to the teacher judgements.
