Drama Workshop

As you are aware, our present topic is the **The Great Fire of London**, and to develop the children's understanding of this period in history and anticipate our future work, we have booked **The Freshwater Theatre Company** to come in and lead a drama session.

We have been involved in work with this company before and have always found the sessions to be great fun, informative and interactive.

Ages of Early Man

One facilitator visits our school in the role of Mary or William Porter, a resident of Pudding Lane in 1666. They will use drama activities such as roleplay and tableaux to explore the topic. The workshop is very interactive.

This workshop gives the children a chance to explore different aspects of the fire, such as what life was like in Pudding Lane beforehand and how the fire happened, and deal with the aftermath. They also get to become the fire, using ribbons and mime in a lovely movement activity.
