## **Section 1 – UK weather, the poles, and the equator (Geography)**

In **Geography**, we will be learning about UK weather, the poles, and the equator.

Look at the list below and choose **one** of the tasks (you may complete more if you wish to):

- Observe and record daily changes in the weather e.g. rain, sun, fog etc for a week in your local area. You can present your findings in picture form or words.
- Compare weather in the UK with weather from another country you may have visited or heard about. Can you present your findings in a picture?
- Find a map of the world – with an adult can you identify countries on the map that are cold and countries that you think might be hot – you may wish to colour hot places red and cold places blue.

## **Section 2 – All about animals (Science)**

Research the various groups that animals belong to *around the world*, e.g. reptiles, amphibian, mammal. Look at the list below and choose **one** of the tasks (you may complete more if you wish to):

- Find out information about one animal in a group. Present your findings through a poster – what have you learned about the animal, any interesting facts, pictures?
- Find out information about one animal in a group. Create a fact file to inform people about your animal.



## **Section 3 – Simple Printmaking (Art)**

In Art, we are learning to use our hands and feet and other mediums to create prints.
