Select 3 pieces of homework you would like to do, and hand in one piece on each date given. Written work can be present by hand or published on the computer.

Piece 1: Pick one

We are learning about The Bronze Age and The Iron Age in History. Complete one of the following tasks:

- Decorate a paper necklace with Bronze Age patterns
- Make a Bronze Age decorated shield
- Compare the life of a person in the Bronze Age with a person today.
- Find out about and describe the jobs that a copper miner used to do
- Create your own roundhouse (an Iron Age home). You may decide to draw and label the different features or create a 3D roundhouse.
- Find out about the clothes the people wore during these different periods. Create a '**Then**' and '**Now**' catalogue of clothes.

Piece 2: Pick one

We will be learning about Forces and Magnets in Science. Complete one of the following tasks:

- Can you design and make a parachute that will slow down a penny falling to earth? You may want to change your design if at first it does not succeed!
- Can you carry out an experiment to show how different surfaces can slow something down? (TIP - High friction surfaces will be ones that do not slide easily)
- Find materials in and around your home that are magnetic. What do you notice about these objects?
- Explore the idea of forces within water. Investigate whether different objects sink or float and think about why this might be happening.

	Choose one of the following tasks to complete:
	 Christmas story Create a booklet telling the Christian story of Christmas Be an animal in the stable and re-tell the Christmas story from your point of view. Be one of the Wise men or shepherds and tell the story from your point of view. Design and make a stable nativity scene.
	Winter Write a short story that includes (at least – so you can include more characters and other settings) the following:
	Setting – The North Pole Character – A penguin Plot – Something or someone is lost!
Spellings	Spellings will be provided weekly- posted on Class Dojo on a Friday and tested the following Friday. They will be linked to our Spelling by Phoneme sessions, as well as the Year 3 Curriculum words.
Maths fluency	For maths fluency, we expect 5-10 minutes of TT Rockstars daily. This is essential in Year 3 as we begin to learn written multiplication methods which rely on the children being confident with the tables learnt so far. We also expect consolidation of the work learnt in class to be done on SplashLearn, completing the tasks set by the teacher.
