Wider curriculum homework

Select 2 pieces of homework you would like to do, and hand in one piece on each date given. Written work can be present by hand or published on the computer.

Homework 1- Hand in on Monday 4th March

Romans – choose 1

- Craft Homework- Create a model of a popular Roman building. Can you label it to say what materials they used to make their buildings.
- Cooking- Make some Roman Honey Cakes and write the recipe. After baking, take a picture or bring them in for us to try!
- Roman Gods- Draw a picture of a Roman God or Goddess. Add information to the picture. What were they God of? Did they have special powers?
- Roman Mosaics – Make your own Roman mosaic using cut paper, pasta shapes, seeds. etc. Keep the design simple.

Homework 2- Hand in Monday 25th March.

Europe- choose 1

- Choose a country in Europe and imagine you have travelled there. Write a postcard to someone back at home to tell them about the country you have visited.
- On a map of Europe, show us the countries you have visited or that are special to you in any way (relatives may have come from there or visited etc) explaining why.
- Create your own European dish, e.g. pasta / pizza / crepes. Write out the recipe and take a photo of your dish.
- Make a travel poster to advertise a country in Europe. Include pictures and persuasive language.
- Make a model of a famous landmark across Europe, e.g. Big Ben, The Eiffel Tower, Leaning tower of Pisa.
- Create a quiz all about Europe to share with the class – you could ask questions about the capital cities, famous landmarks or famous people from Europe.
- Research a country in Europe that is special to you or that interests you. Create a fact file for this country.

Spellings

Spellings will be provided weekly- posted on Class Dojo on a Friday and tested the following Friday. They will be linked to our Spelling by Phoneme sessions, as well as the Year 3 Curriculum words.

Maths fluency

For maths fluency, we expect 5-10 minutes of TT Rockstars daily. We also expect consolidation of the work learnt in class to be done on SplashLearn, completing the tasks set by the teacher.
