Present this data in a chart of your choice e.g. bar graph/pie chart (Maths and Computing) - Bake your own space-themed cookies, cakes or biscuits, measuring all the ingredients yourself. They could be star, planet or rocket-shaped. Or something else! (DT and Maths) - Create your own space-themed Top Trumps cards. Can you use numbers up to hundreds of thousands? (Maths and Art) - Make an acrostic poem for one of the planets (English) - Design your own planet and describe it (Art and English) - Create a timeline to show the history of Space travel (History) - Create a factsheet or presentation with some independent research about Brazil (Geography)
