(Science)</li><li>- Create a fact sheet about the Empire Windrush (History and English)</li><li>- Create a one-minute video that uses panning, tilting and zooming shots (Computing)</li><li>- Learn part of your favourite pop ballad and video/perform it to the class. This could be done in pairs, or a small group (Music)</li><li>- Research a child or young person who has had a positive impact on society (PSHE)</li><li>- Create a step-by-step poster for how to multiply or divide by powers of 10. You could include place value charts and show how the digits move (Maths)</li></ul> |
