(History) - The Maya were great farmers and enjoyed eating tortillas filled with cooked vegetables! Can you design your own Maya tortilla recipe and make it with your family? Send in a photo of your design (DT/History) - Can you draw or make a Maya temple? Write about why the temples were so important to the Maya. (History)
