"I liked going on the top of the bus!"

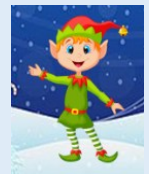

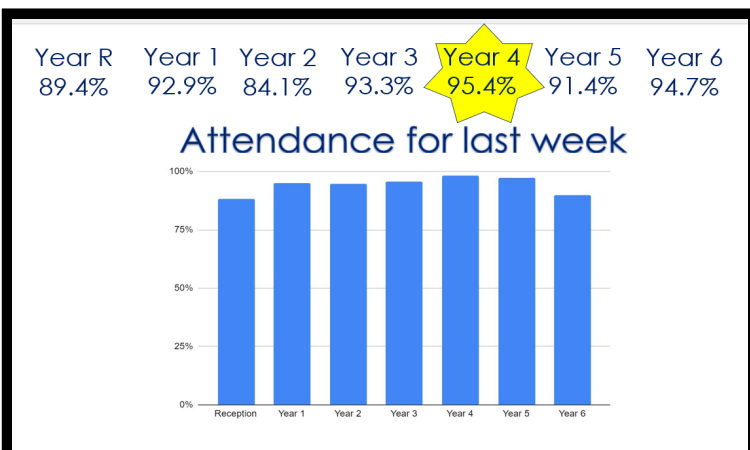
