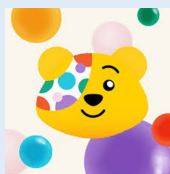
Travelling Book Fair

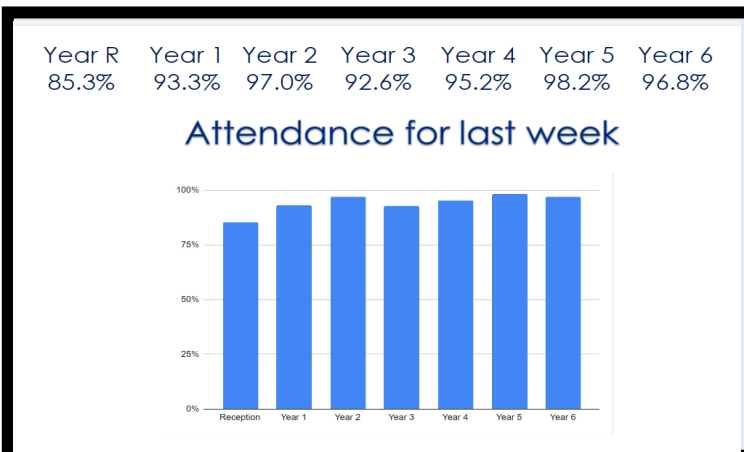

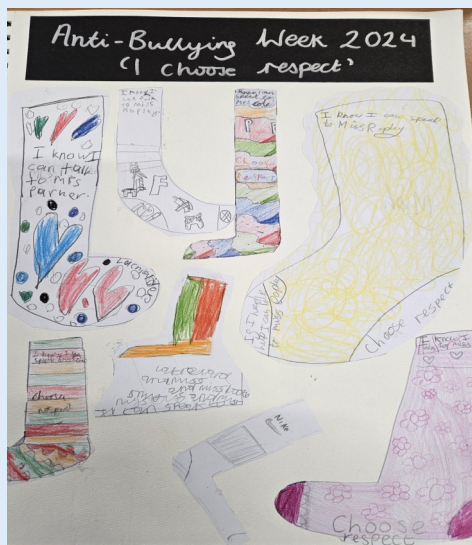
