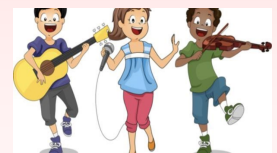
Christmas Dinner

PARKING

We have received several concerns which have been raised by residents about parking outside the school and surrounding streets. On several occasions, parents have been reminded to be considerate of where they park around the school. To improve safety, there are painted zig zag and double yellow lines in specific areas outside the school. **There should be no stopping or parking in any of these areas.** Parking across residents driveways is also not acceptable. Please remember that the school is located in a residential area.

I appreciate that it can sometimes be difficult to park near the school, but parking dangerously is putting children at risk. Please allow yourself extra time to park away from the school and walk round with your child.
