I wish all our families a peaceful and well-deserved break and we look forward to welcoming you back in 2025!

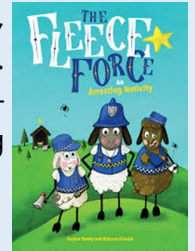

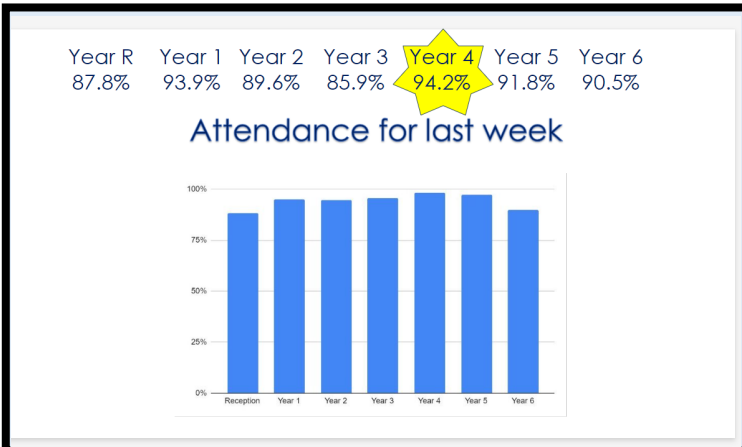
