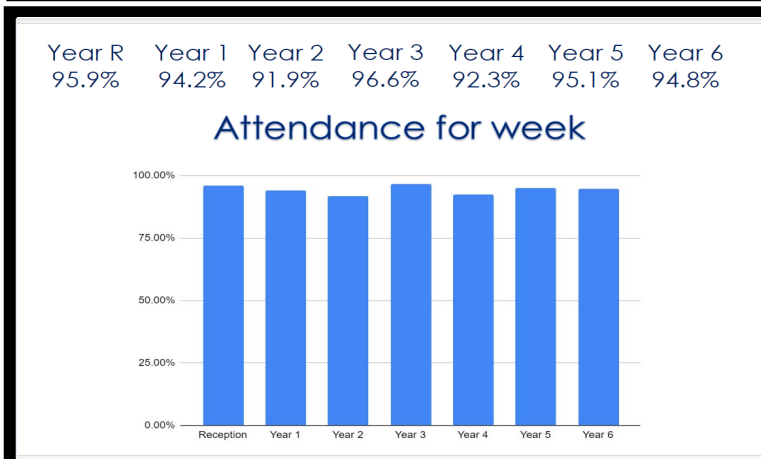

Remember to submit meter readings on



Energy Prices are going up on 1st January 2024.

It is important to submit meter readings to ensure your energy company does not overestimate how much gas and electricity you used at the higher prices*



You can submit a meter reading up to a week after it has been taken

If you haven't submitted a meter reading for a while, take a date stamped photo as evidence. Ensure your photo is of the whole meter and the meter serial number is clear

If you are unable to read your meter, let your energy company know.

*If you have a Smart Meter, your energy company should get readings automatically
