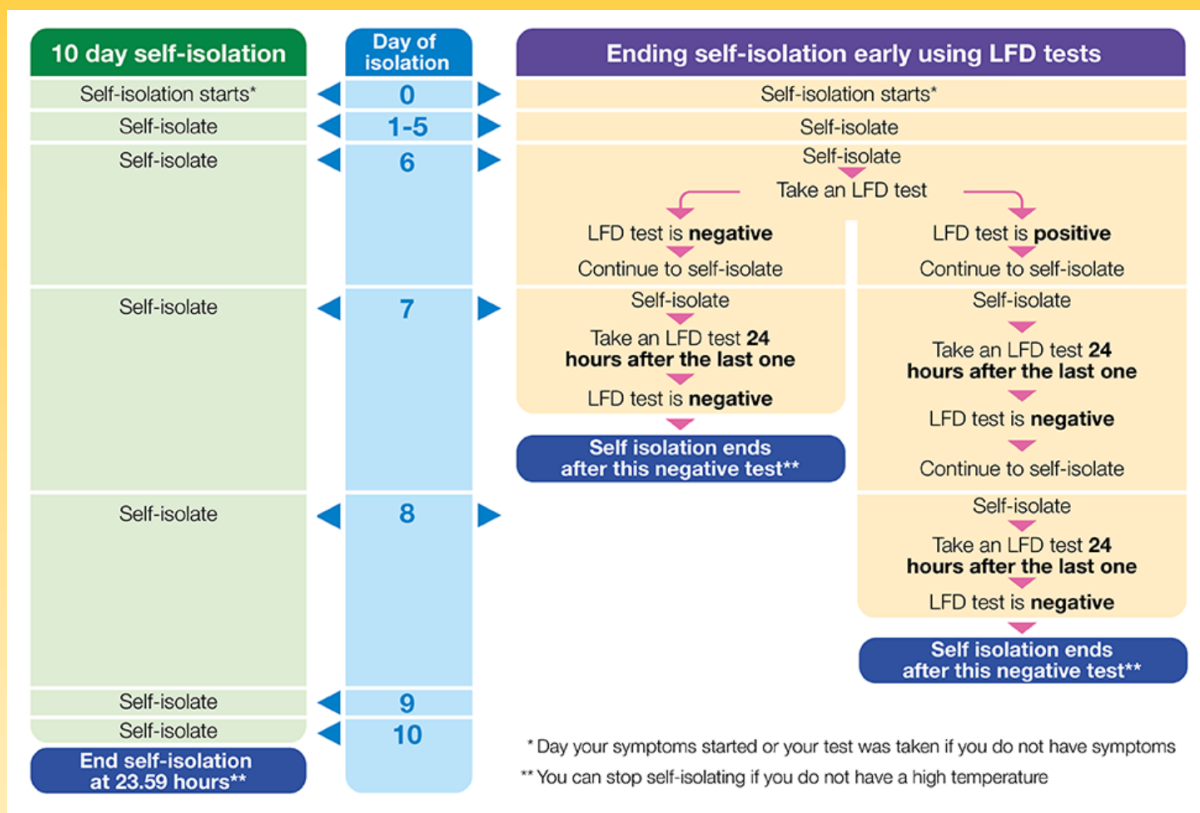


### Happy New Year

It has been great to welcome the children back this week. They have settled well into the new school term, and I have been really pleased to see all the hard work they have been doing in class this week. Curriculum letters will be sent next Wednesday, which will give details of what the children will be learning this term. Homework letters will also be sent home next Wednesday.

### Covid-19

There have been some changes to the requirements for testing and isolation brought in by the Government. These changes are laid out in the table below:



To give an example of what this means: if an individual has a positive lateral flow test on a Monday they should self-isolate. The following Sunday, they can do a further lateral flow test. If the test is negative, they should wait 24 hours and do another lateral flow test. If the second lateral flow test is negative, the self-isolation ends and the individual may return to school on that Monday.

In order for an individual to return to school on Day 7, the lateral flow tests on both day 6 and day 7 should be taken prior to 8.00am, so that there is the required 24 hours between the tests and ample time to get ready for the school day. If the test is taken **later** in the day, then the child should return to school on Day 8.

If the day 6 test is positive, then the individual should continue to self-isolate until they have had 2 negative tests 24 hours apart.

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## Parking

Please ensure you think carefully when parking in roads around the school. Parents should not be parking on the zigzags, double yellow lines or across our neighbours' driveways.

We are fortunate to have ample legal parking in the roads around the school, however some parents are continuing to park in areas which are causing obstructions to other road users or making it dangerous for our families to safely cross the road. This includes parking on the corner of Mosslea Road, which causes huge congestion outside of the school.

Please be mindful and help keep our children safe.



Please ensure that school dinners are booked before midnight on Thursdays for the following week.

Last term, the booking system worked well and ensured all children were able to have their chosen meals.

All meals (whether paid or free) must be booked and paid for via Parentpay.
