It is up to you when and how you do these activities. These activities are in addition to weekly homework, words and reading and you may pick and choose which ones suit your child best.

Reception activities to enjoy at home

## Activity tick list

- Continue to learn to write your name by yourself using lower case letters that are formed correctly.
- Write words and simple sentences independently using phonic sounds and common exception words correctly. For example: **The cat is hot. I can see the dog.**
- Log onto You Tube (parental supervision required) and look for "Read Write inc speed sounds set 1 and 2"- to revisit the sounds we have been learning at school.
- Practise reading and writing numbers to **5, 10 and 20.**
- Read to your child every day, encourage them to join in with the story and repeat parts of the story using the pictures to help them. Ask them questions about what they have read.
- Practise blending CVC words example g e t ask your child to say each sound then put them together to say the word.
- Help your child become independent and encourage them to put on their own shoes, hats and gloves and zip up their coats.
- Do puzzles or colouring activities with your child to help them learn how to listen and sit still for a short amount of time.
- Play a board game with your friends and family, playing board games will help you learn to share, take turns, win, lose and count.
- Continue to develop your child's fine motor skills (hand strength) do lots of activities involving playdough, cutting with child safe scissors and threading activities.
- Practise reading and writing common exception words which are sent home to you every 2 weeks.
