Welcome back!	This is your Summer 1 home learning sheet. These activities are in addition to weekly homework, spellings and reading and you may pick and choose which ones suit your child best. We would encourage you to try more of these activities as we only have one term left in Reception!
Reception activities to enjoy at home	<p><b>Activity tick list</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Write words and simple sentences independently using phonic sounds and common exception words correctly. Use capital letters, full stops and finger spaces <b>consistently</b>. For example: <b>The cat is hot. I like the cat and it is pink.</b></li><li>○ Log onto You Tube (parental supervision required) and look for "Read Write inc speed sounds set 2/3"- to revisit the sounds we have been learning at school.</li><li>○ Practise reading and writing numbers to <b>10 and 20</b>.</li><li>○ Practise reading and writing common exception words, these are words we use in many aspects of our lives and it is good for children to become very familiar with them: <b>mum, dad, cat, dog, I, my, like, can, big, see, me, we, she, he, and, the, love, to, in, up, on, get, it, you.</b></li><li>○ Read to your child every day, encourage them to join in with the story and repeat parts of the story using the pictures to help them.</li><li>○ Help your child become resilient and encourage them to do more things independently.</li><li>○ Practise reading and writing common exception words which are sent home to you every 2 weeks.</li><li>○ Re-visit skills taught in maths including <b>subitising, doubling, odd and even numbers adding and subtracting.</b></li></ul>
