Children enjoyed today's Harvest Assembly, led by Reverend Elizabeth Goodridge from All Saints' Church who shared the significance of Harvest for Christians.

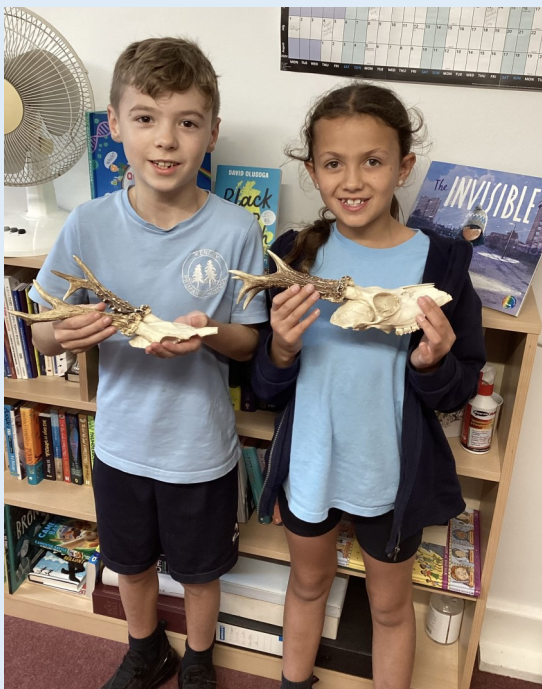

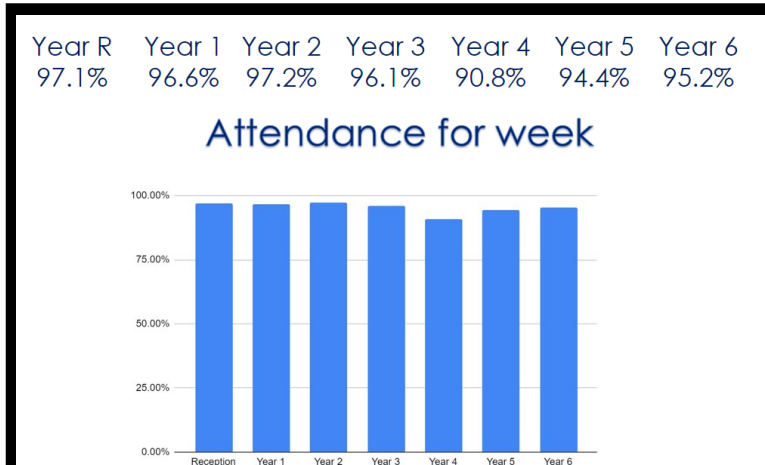
