Year 5 & Year 6 Residential 2024 - Aylmerton Outdoor Education Centre

We are delighted to inform you that a four-day residential, educational, adventure week for year 5 and 6 pupils, from Sunday 30th June to Wednesday 3rd July has been organised, which will be at Aylmerton Outdoor Education Centre in Norfolk.

Aylmerton is a leading residential organisation, providing a wide range of adventure and educational activities. Activities are all organised and led by Aylmerton personnel who are trained to run them. There is a full program for the children including evening entertainment. The children will always be accompanied by staff from Kenley. Residential visits are optional, but pupils do hugely benefit from the experience.

Children will stay in single-sex, dormitory-style rooms. The centre offers a selection of food, with plenty of choice for all - any specific dietary requirements can be catered for upon request.

The cost of the trip will be £360.00, which includes return transport by private coach, accommodation, all meals, and the activity sessions. If you wish your child to attend, **a £48.00 non-refundable deposit is required to be paid before Thursday 1st February via ParentPay.**

So that final numbers can be confirmed with Aylmerton by this date, **please also [click here](#) and complete the electronic form.**

Once the deposit has been paid the remaining balance can be paid in 6 instalments of £52. There is also the option to pay as much as you wish to or are able to between now and July - when the final payment will be due. All payments can be made via ParentPay.

If financial assistance may be required, ie you are eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals (Pupil Premium), please contact the office. All enquiries are treated confidentially.

A meeting will be held closer to the time the children will be going to Aylmerton, which will provide details of the week such as the children's activities timetable, what to pack, and to answer any specific questions.
