Dear Parents and Carers,

As I am sure you are all aware from this week's government announcement, we will be welcoming back all pupils from the week beginning 8th March. We are really excited about the pupils returning to school and are very much looking forward to seeing everybody.

We have been working through the DfE guidance on the full opening and will be able to operate the school in much the same way as we did in the Autumn term. We will continue with the staggered start and finish times, pupils will need to wear PE kit on their PE days and we will be minimising adults on the school site particularly within the buildings. We will also have additional measures in place from the 8th March including all staff wearing face covering in communal areas.

Breakfast and afterschool club will be open, booking should be made directly with SimplyKids. Please be aware that pupils from different bubbles will be attending the provision, although there are currently reduced numbers. SimplyKids are ensuring that children from different bubbles are distanced where possible, the hall is well ventilated and additional cleaning measures are in place. In accordance with DfE guidance, we will not be operating any other extra curricula clubs for the remainder of this term.

A letter will be sent next week reminding parents of the timings of the day and outlining the measures being put in place to reduce risks to both staff and pupils.

We are all looking forward to the children's return, and in the meantime if you have any concerns about the return to school, please let us know.
